ABOUT SCHOLARS OLYMPIAD

The Scholars Olympiad is a structured academic assessment designed to enhance conceptual understanding, analytical reasoning, and problem-solving skills among students from Classes 1–10. The examination framework aligns with the curriculum of the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and the Council for the Indian Certificate School Examinations (ICSE), and is suitably adapted for learners from the International Baccalaureate (IB) curriculum.

- Strengthen core academic concepts across subjects
- Develop higher-order and analytical thinking, logical reasoning and academic confidence
- Provide exposure to a competitive academic environment
- Identify and nurture academic talent at an early stage

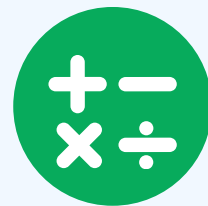

Mode of Conduct

- Examination to be conducted within school premises during school hours/ Stay-back timings
- Schools may select either of the two available dates for each subject
- Question papers and instructions will be provided in advance
- Evaluation will be conducted centrally
- Admit cards will be provided for students to appear for the tests

SCHOLARS CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT (DIGITAL)

Awarded to students who:

1. Rank among the Top 25% of participants in their class and subject; and
2. Secure a minimum score of 60% of the total marks.
3. Minimum school participation of 50 students.

Note: School-level ranks and medals will be awarded only if there are:

- Minimum 10 participants in that class and subject in the school, subject to a total participation of 50 students.
- If a minimum of 20 participants is achieved in the respective class and subject in a school, School Trophies (Ranks 1–3) shall be awarded for that class and subject. In categories with fewer than 20 participants, medals shall be awarded instead.

Principal Leadership Award

(Presented to the Principal for promoting academic excellence and participation.)

Teacher Mentor Award

(Presented to the School Coordinator for outstanding support and coordination.)

- Certificate and Gift
- Subject to a minimum of 100 registrations.



..... SPECIAL AWARDS

Young Scholar Award (at National & School Level)

Highest aggregate score across all subjects in each class.

To recognise the best all-round performer in a class.

Eligibility

A student must:

- Appear in all three subjects (English, Mathematics, and Science); and
- Obtain the highest aggregate marks in that class.

Emerging Scholar Award

- Most improved performance by a school (from the previous year).
- Based on total number of registrations and overall average score.

Scholars Star School Award

For schools with:

- Minimum 100 registrations across all classes and subjects; and Outstanding overall performance

Scholars National Girl Child Excellence Award

- Awarded to the highest-scoring girl student in each class at the national level, based on aggregate performance in English, Mathematics, and Science, subject to the prescribed eligibility criteria.

Scholars National Girl Child Scholarship

- Awarded to exceptional girl students (Max. 10) demonstrating outstanding academic achievement and potential. The number, nature, and value of the educational scholarships shall be determined by the Organising Committee.
